



# Highland Scarf

## Materials:

4 skeins Debbie Bliss Como  
US size 15 needles  
cable needle  
tapestry needle

**Size:** Sample is approximately 5" x 43". Make it as long as you like! Each additional skein will make about 3 more pattern repeats.

**Gauge:** 3.5 st = 1" in rib stitch; 2.25 st = 1" in st st  
Gauge is not critical. This pattern can be used with a variety of yarns and weights, resulting in varying widths.

## Instructions:

Cast on 24 stitches

Rows 1 through 7 - \*K1, P1\*

Row 8- Slip first 6 stitches to a cable needle, hold to front of work, work next 6 stitches in established pattern, work stitches from cable needle. Slip next 6 stitches to a cable needle, hold to back of work, work next 6 stitches in established pattern, work stitches from cable needle.

## Pattern:

Rows 1 through 13 - \*K1, P1\*

Row 14- Slip first 6 stitches to a cable needle, hold to front of work, work next 6 stitches in established pattern, work stitches from cable needle.

Slip next 6 stitches to a cable needle, hold to back of work, work next 6 stitches in established pattern, work stitches from cable needle.

Continue to desire length, bind off in pattern on row 8.

Wear it hanging straight or wrapped around your neck like a cozy cowl. You can pass one end through one of the holes created by the pattern to hold it closed. Easy and fun to make and so versatile! Enjoy!

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
